EA1157/15 Apologies for Absence

Apologies were received from Cllr Kataria.

EA1158/15 Declarations of Interest

The Chairman recommended that any declarations of interest be made, if necessary, throughout the meeting.

EA1159/15 Representations from the Public

There were no members of the public present.

EA1160/15 Minutes

The Clerk apologised that the Agenda should have included an item to approve the Minutes of the Meeting held on 1 September. The Clerk added that this can be addressed at this meeting under Standing Order 9.1.3 to approve the accuracy of the minutes of the previous meeting, a motion that does not require written notice.

Resolved:

- That the Minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 1 September 2015 be approved and be signed by the Chairman.

Matters Arising

The Clerk advised that this item would be taken under Standing Order 9.1.26 to answer questions from councillors. Under EA1146/15 Matters Arising, EA1139/15 Works List, it was asked whether there had been further complaints regarding the removal of the dog bin in Mill Lane. The Clerk advised that he had not received any further complaints but a site meeting was scheduled in the near future between interested parties to resolve the litter problem.

EA1161/15 Works List

The Chairman introduced this item and invited any comments. The Clerk brought Members attention to an additional entry under Foot Path No.17 where clearing the path surface of mud and leaves had been added.

EA1162/15 Budgets 2016/17

The Chairman introduced this item and asked the Clerk to elaborate. The Clerk

referred to pages 8 to 12 of the budget schedule v3 dated 16 October 2105 circulated with the Agenda.

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The Clerk added that he had included a nominal sum (£500) for fly tipping removal in the unfortunate event such a situation arose. A discussion ensued as to whether the sum included would be sufficient but it was noted that such costs cannot be foreseen.

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
