Brass Band and Market

Introduction

To agree that an event can be planned to take place on the 19 December 2015. The Brass band has been booked provisionally and also a possible market has been provisionally agreed. The venue would take place around the library.

Discussion Narrative

Cllr Brand had proposed to set up a picnic in the park using the brass band for the music. This has not taken place, although various options were considered. Instead of this, it has been proposed to book the band to play Christmas music outside the library by the Christmas tree. The funds would be met from the picnic in the park budget.

Cllr Mitchell has been trying to set up a market in Croxley Green for a while, and has had useful talks to the owner of "the Little Fox market". They can also bring in a few stalls for that day. Discussion with the Library last year did say that they are open to the idea. If the licences can be obtained, and costs paid for out of the picnic in the park budget, then the two events could become one.

Recommendation(s)

- Agree the viement of funds from the picnic in the park budget (up to £500) to book the brass band and obtain licenses for the market and music.
- To delegate to the Clerk to progress this event working with Cllrs Brand and Mitchell.
