#### **Remembrance Sunday Parade**

##### **Introduction**

Each year the Parish Council, in conjunction with the Royal British Legion, organises a Remembrance Sunday ceremony at the War Memorial on The Green after a service at All Saints Church. This year it will take place on Sunday 8 November.

Prior to the church service there is a parade involving The Royal British Legion, The Royal British Legion Ladies, Any Service Organisation, The Sea Cadets, Red Cross, Scouts, Guides, Boys Brigade, Girls Brigade and any others.

The parade forms at the end of Dickinson Avenue adjacent to Yorke Road at 1.45pm for 2.00pm and marches off at 2.15pm to All Saints' Church. The church service is at 2.30pm.

The Clerk arranges a temporary road closure with the Police in order for the parade to be able to walk on the road.

In recent years it has not been possible to get a marching band to accompany the parade so recorded music has been used via a loudspeaker mounted on a vehicle.

##### **Discussion Narrative**

The Royal British Legion have been in contact with the Chiltern Brass Band and although they have to perform at an earlier Remembrance Service on Sunday 8 November, this is in the morning.

They have provisionally confirmed that they would be available to form part of the parade for this Council's ceremony. The Royal British Legion have been able to negotiate a price of £250.

##### **Recommendation(s)**

- That the Parish Council agrees to fund the brass band to accompany the parade at a cost of £250;
