A short 3 minute presentation was then given by Mrs Wendy Jordan on behalf of the Croxley Green Residents Association requesting the Council to consider the development of a Parish Plan fro Croxley Green. Points raised included:

- Harnessing the resources within Croxley to develop the Plan;
- The development of the Plan would be led by the Parish Council;
- Such a Plan would be a pro-active initiative rather than being reactive to circumstances:
- The Plan would support and underpin the Parish Council's objectives;
- There was strong support within the community for such a plan and this would be the foundation of 'grass root' support and community involvement in setting out a plan for Croxley Green for the future;
- The necessity for a questionnaire to residents to ascertain views;
- The plan would need to cover a policy for young people, the need for a leisure centre within Croxley and the need for an additional secondary school.

PD1486/10 Parish Plan

The Chairman opened this matter by seeking the views of Members on the matter of the Parish Council developing a Parish Plan.

Members present stated that this was a great opportunity to take advantage of the offer made by the Residents Association to assist in developing a working group and subsequent sub Committee of the Council to take such a Plan forward. There was full support towards this initiative. The Clerk advised that Sarratt Parish Council were also in the process of developing a Parish Plan and that they had already circulated a questionnaire to residents which resulted in a 61% response. The Clerk added that he would contact Sarratt Parish Council to obtain more information.

 That the Planning and Development Committee recommend to full Council that a Parish Plan for Croxley Green be developed with the Parish Council taking the lead.
