Budgets 2011/12 and Beyond

The Chairman introduced this item and the Clerk advised that currently next year's budget for the Environment and Amenity Committee stood at £47,940 (last year's sum was £31,050).

The Clerk advised that at the last meeting a sum of £20,000 had been included towards updating another play area within Croxley Green. The Clerk referred to the TRDC Executive Committee Minutes of 1 November which advised that subject to funding becoming available to TRDC their priority would be upgrading play areas in South Oxhey and Carpenders Park. The Clerk added that as TRDC would not be partially funding any upgrade of play areas in Croxley, then the £20,000 provision should be reduced and funds progressively built up over a number of years for when a joint venture for upgrading play areas in Croxley could take place.

A Cllr raised the matter that a lot of TRDC monies are spent outside Croxley to which he was advised that the District Council has a wider responsibility than just Croxley Green. It was added that Croxley Green had benefitted from the upgrading of Barton Way Play Area and that the Skate Park in Baldwins Lane was also due to be resurfaced.

Resolved

- that the Development of Play Area provision in the budget be reduced to £10,000 and that a counter sum be earmarked from Reserves to sustain the

2011/12 budget to the same level as 2010/11 i.e £6,890 from Reserves to sustain the budget with a zero increase at £31,050.

A Cllr raised the matter of dog waste disposal and whether this could be undertaken by the Rangers. It was pointed out that there were Health and Safety implications and a Controlled Waste Disposal Licence would be required. The Cllr then asked whether TRDC could undertake the dog waste disposal. A District Cllr agreed to raise the matter internally with TRDC but it was emphasised that there still would be a cost to Croxley Green residents by way of Special Expenses if such a situation was eventually considered as viable.
