Defibrillators

Introduction

Members will recall that at the Council Meeting in July 2015 (Minute CC1507/15), it was agreed that the Council would fund the connection and ongoing maintenance costs of two CPADS (public access defibrillators). The Croxley Green Residents Association had received a grant of £2,900 from District Cllr Steve Drury for the purchase of two CPADS and the Parish Council allocated £400 towards their installation.

Discussion Narrative

Since the time the Parish Council agreed to fund the connection and to provide ongoing maintenance for the defibrillators that would be purchased via the grant from District Cllr Steve Drury, despite many attempts to get updates as to where we are with the project, no response has been received. I have written to both parties expressing concern but once again no response has been received.

Recommendation(s)

- That the Parish Council withdraws from its arrangement to fund the connection and maintenance of the county grant funded defibrillators;
- That the Parish Council use their own funding as detailed in the Council's 2016/17 budget to set up a defibrillator network.
