## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

- **A controlled parking zone (CPZ) is an area consisting of a group of roads with common restrictions on parking. Common features of CPZ's include Single yellow lines, double yellow lines, marked parking bays and signs. The restrictions in a CPZ are enforced by a Traffic Regulation Order which is a legal document.**
- **Parking restrictions in CPZ can operate all – day (usually between the 8am and 6.30pm) or for specific hours during the day eg. 11:00 to midday or 09:00am to 11:00.**
- **Residents can purchase parking permits for use by themselves and their visitors in a CPZ.**
- **These parking permits are subject to charges set by the Local District Council.**
- **CPZ's are used to prioritise parking for residents but they are not used to allocate parking spaces for specific individuals.**
- **Parking Restrictions such as double yellow lines and Single yellow lines can be introduced at certain locations without necessarily being part of a CPZ.**
- **Double yellow lines and Single yellow lines can be installed at junctions and bends to improve visibility and prevent obstructive parking**
