Additional Dog Bin between Common Moor and Byewaters estate

Introduction

Close to the weir on the River Gade is a set of steps between Croxley Common Moor and the Byewaters estate. Due to the number of dog walkers that enter and leave the Moor via these steps it has become a dumping ground for dog waste bags as there is no suitable receptacle available.

Discussion

Whether it is feasible/practical/financially viable to provide an additional dog waste disposal bin in the vicinity of the aforementioned steps. The purchase cost of a new dog bin would be in the order of £150 and the additional cost of emptying would up to £4.80 per week if emptied twice a week (2 x £2.40 per week).

Recommendation(s)

- That Croxley Green Parish Council provides funds to place an additional dog waste bin close to the steps between the Byewaters estate and Croxley Common Moor;
- That Croxley Green Parish Council increases their annual commitment to their environmental contractor to maintain/empty said bin;
- That the Clerk be given discretion to determine whether the new bin, if agreed, be emptied once a week or twice week;
- That the above recommendations, if approved, be referred to Council for ratification.
