

CROXLEY GREEN TREASURE TRAIL

Treasure is buried at the Croxley Green Parish Council office, but can only be accessed using a password hidden at a secret location. Each clue below will help you cross off the location numbers on the left hand side of the map (overleaf), until there is just 1 location left. This is where you will find the password. Please note, children should be supervised by an adult at all times, and where numbers are referenced below, these are whole numbers (i.e. 21 would not be considered 2 & 1)

YOUR TRAIL BEGINS IN THE COMMUNITY WAY CARPARK, WD3 3PA, (BY LOCATION 23 OVERLEAF)

1. Make your way to the corner of the carpark closest the Parish Council office. Find the parking restriction sign. The password is not at a location number featured so cross off the locations with these numbers on the map overleaf.
2. From the parking sign, take the path on your left, in front of the Community Centre. After a few steps, bear right to enter the playing field, noting the numbers on the dog bin on your right hand side shortly after the playing field entrance. The password is not at a location with any of these numbers featured, or any other numbers featured on dog bins along your treasure trail. You won't need include any dog bins on the other side of a road.
3. As the concrete path narrows and bends to the left, keep straight onto the dirt path entering Stone's Orchard. After a few minutes the dirt path ends in Stone's Orchard and you'll find a bench on your right hand side. The password location starts with one of the letters on the sides of the bench.
4. Go past the bench and cut through the gap in the bushes in front of you. When you meet some crossing paths stay to the right. When you exit the orchard onto a footpath turn right and follow this round towards Owens Way.
5. As you enter Owens Way you'll notice a green island with trees planted. Find the square inspection hatch in the grass. The location does not start with the 2nd vowel of the word featured on the hatch.
6. From the end of the island walk past 3 lampposts on your left hand side. Just before the 4th lamppost take the footpath on your left until you reach Baldwins Lane play area. Look at the large sign, what colour is the roundabout in the picture? This colour is not in the password location name. Remember to keep crossing off locations matching the numbers on dog bins. Hint: There's one behind you!
7. Carry on through the park walking to the opposite corner you entered from, past the skate park and towards the tennis courts. Exit onto Baldwins Lane stopping at the large green playing fields sign. Add the last two digits of the telephone listed together. The password is not at this location number.
8. Turn left on Baldwins Lane towards The Green. Where The Green meets Baldwins Lane there is a "Welcome to Croxley Green" sign with a red outlined shape at the top. Add up the number of sides this shape has and multiply by 7. The password is not at this location number.
9. Turn left onto The Green, staying on the left hand side of the road, and walk towards the pubs. Opposite the Coach and Horses pub you'll notice a "parking on the green is prohibited sign" the colour of the pole this sign is attached to does not feature in the password location name
10. Turn left down New Road. Noting the speed limit sign as you enter the road. The password location is not at this number.
11. When you come to the Methodist Church on your right hand side, look for the stone laid by someone with the surname Rance. The first initial does not feature in the location of the password.
12. Continue down New Road, counting the lampposts on your right hand side. On the 7th Lamppost outside the Co-Op there a 2 digit number in black text with white background. The password is not at this location.
13. You should have 3 options left on your treasure map. The password is at the highest number location you have left. Head there now and look for a noticeboard with the treasure password listed along with this symbol 📖

Once you have the password visit Croxley Green Parish Council office during opening hours to collect your treasure (Mon-Thurs 9am-4pm or Friday 9am-1pm)

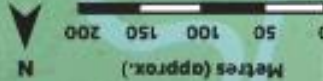
