#### **Mill Lane Parking**

##### **Background**

Cars parked at the bottom of Mill Lane, adjacent to the Canal, reduce the width of access to the Canal and Common Moor causing a problem for pedestrians, cyclists etc. Knee high fencing was put up by Croxley Green Parish Council to prevent cars being parked on the boundary of Weston Wood.

##### **Discussion**

Cars parked at the bottom of Mill Lane should be discouraged to facilitate ease of access to the Canal and Common Moor by all visitors and emergency vehicles. It is proposed to produce and install Croxley Green Parish Council branded No Parking Signs to dissuade car owners from parking at the bottom of Mill Lane. A sign like the picture below could be produced and installed on wooden bollards on Mill Lane.

##### **Recommendations**

- To allocate a budget of £200 to purchase and install up to 4 Croxley Green Parish Council branded No Parking Signs and wooden poles.
