

Rules of the 2020 Virtual Photography Competition  
(referred to as the Competition)

In these Rules

"You" or "Entrant" mean	A entrant to the Competition
"CGPC" means	Croxley Green Parish Council
"Entry" means	A single photograph entered in this Competition

By entering the Competition You hereby accept these Competition Rules.

1. The Competition is free to enter.
- 1.2 The Competition is open to all members of the public who study, live, work or play sports in Croxley Green
- 1.3 Entries must be submitted by 20 December 2020 - midnight.
- 1.4 By entering the Competition, You agree and acknowledge that CGPC is permitted to receive Your registration data. All personal information will be used by CGPC in accordance with its Privacy Policy.
- 1.5 To enter, You must upload your image via links posted on CGPC Facebook page.
- 1.6 Images should be no smaller than 1MB and no larger than 5MB. Images should be JPEG files. All images must be saved in the sRGB color model.
2. Judging
  - 2.2 Entries will be judged between 21 December and 23 December 2020
  - 2.3 A shortlist of up to ten photographs from each category will be selected for judging by the judges.
  - 2.4 The individual category winners and the overall winner will be voted for by the Judges.
  - 2.5 The decision of the Judges and CGPC is final and no negotiation will be entered into with respect to any such decision.
3. Each Entrant can submit one image in one category.
4. CGPC reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify and remove any entry that does not comply with the following requirements, even after the entry is submitted on the Website.
5. You warrant and represent, in respect of each entry submitted by You ("Entry"), as follows:
  - 5.2 You are the sole owner and author of each Entry
  - 5.3 You have the right to make Your Entry available to the Competition
  - 5.4 Each Entry does not contain personally identifiable information about You or any other person(s)
  - 5.5 Each Entry does not contain any infringing, threatening, false, misleading, abusive, harassing, libellous, defamatory, vulgar, obscene, scandalous, inflammatory, pornographic or profane content
  - 5.6 Each Entry does not contain any material that could constitute or encourage conduct which would be considered a criminal offense, give rise to civil liability, or otherwise violate any law
  - 5.7 Each Entry does not infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks, contract rights, or any other intellectual property rights of any third person or entity, or violate any person's rights of privacy or publicity, including:
    - 5.7.2 trademarks owned by third parties
    - 5.7.3 copyrighted materials owned by third parties

- 5.7.4 names, likenesses, or other characteristics identifying celebrities or other public figures, living or dead
- 5.7.5 Entries which contain any commercial content that promotes any product or service.
- 5.7.6 Entries containing screen credits
- 5.8 No animals were harmed or manipulated in the making of the image
- 5.9 You agree to fully indemnify CGPC in respect of all royalties, fees and any other monies owing to any person due to Your breaching any of the foregoing.
- 5.10 You confirm that each person depicted in the Entry has granted permission to be portrayed as shown. Any costumes, props or other materials used must be rented or borrowed with the permission of the owner, and all other relevant permissions must have been obtained.
6. If You are under 16, You have Your parent's or legal guardian's consent to participate in the Competition.
- 6.2 If CGPC does not receive a valid signed parental or legal guardian consent form for any winner under the age of 16 within 7 clear days of the Entrant being declared a winner, CGPC will be entitled to select an alternative winner from among the Entrants.
7. CGPC may run an online rating process whereby members of the public may vote for a favourite photograph. If there is sufficient evidence (in CGPC's sole discretion) to suggest malpractice and manipulation of the rating process, then CGPC has the right to remove the relevant Entry or Entries and, if necessary, award the prize to a different Entrant. CGPC's decisions are final.
8. CGPC recognizes You, the author of the image, retain full ownership of the copyright in each Entry.
9. All Entrants understand that any image submitted to the competition may be used by CGPC, for marketing and promotional purposes. You hereby grant CGPC a non-exclusive, irrevocable licence in each Entry for three years in all media for any use connected to the, including, but not limited to:
  - (a) judging the Competition
  - (b) displaying the winning entries and runners up
  - (c) inclusion within the Website, magazine or similar
  - (d) inclusion within any materials promoting of the Competition organised by CGPC
  - (e) allowing viewers of the Website and to view images on a computer screen, PDA or mobile telephone and store such pages in electronic form on disk or on a PDA or mobile telephone for their personal, non-commercial use only.
10. In no event will CGPC or its officers or members be responsible or liable for any damages or losses of any kind, including direct, indirect, incidental, consequential, special or punitive damages arising out of any Entrant's access to and use of the Council's Facebook pages.
11. All Entrants must be able to supply a high-resolution image suitable for printing in media and an exhibition should the image be required.
12. There are no alternatives to the gift tokens available for prizewinners.
13. Winners will be announced online.
14. In no circumstances will CGPC, its officers or members be responsible for any damages or losses of any kind, including direct, indirect, incidental, consequential, special or punitive damages arising out of any cancellation or rescheduling of the competition.
