JC100/12 Introductions

JC101/12 Appointment of a Junior Chairperson

Hannah Jones of Harvey Road School was appointed to Chair the meeting.

The Minutes of the meeting held on 17 January 2012 were approved and signed by the Chairman.

JC102/12 Actions and Campaigns

Following the last meeting of the Junior Council, suggestions for future projects had been discussed by the Junior Councillors at their schools.

The Junior Councillors suggested that the schools could write articles for the Parish Pump magazine and also include quizzes such as word searches to encourage children to read the magazine. Some of the Junior Cllrs were keen to write an article expressing their concern about the amount of new development in Croxley Green. It was agreed that Little Green School would write an article about this and that Harvey Road School would devise a word search puzzle and they would submit these by Tuesday 20 March. It was asked that if Yorke Mead School have anything to submit that they do so by 20 March.

Harvey Road school advised that they had watched the online virtual tour of the Croxley Rail Link and whilst some of the children had been in favour of the scheme, some had been against it.

A discussion took place about the Revels and the Junior Cllrs were in favour of having a section of the Parish Council's stall this year. It was agreed that Harvey Road school would create a colouring competition with an Olympic theme and Little Green School would create a quiz with a 'bugs' theme to fit in with this year's Parish Council theme of biodiversity. It was requested that Yorke Mead School be asked to do something with a Jubilee theme. Junior Cllrs agreed to devise a rota so that their sections would be covered during the Revels.
