MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE

- EA639/10 Apologies for Absence
Apologies were received from Cllrs Martin and Vassiliou.
- EA640/10 Declarations of Interest
There were no declarations of interest.
- EA641/10 Representations from the Public
There were no members of public present.
- EA642/10 Minutes
It was proposed by Cllr Seeley and seconded by Cllr Jefford that the Minutes of the meeting held on 5 January 2010 be approved as correct. The proposal was agreed and the Chairman signed the minutes.
- EA643/10 Matters Arising
EA632/10; EA624/09 Active Works List. The Chairman advised Members that the Clerk had been in contact with Cllr Drury of Three Rivers District Council (TRDC) to find out if Hertfordshire County Council would be willing to supply the Parish Council with salt for its salt bins. It was asked which committee was dealing with salt bins and it was confirmed that this would come under the remit of the Planning and Development Committee.
- EA644/10 Active Works List
The Chairman introduced this item and Members were referred to the active works list which had been circulated with the Agenda. It was asked why the Land Rover had been taken to the sign shop and it was clarified that the new email address had been updated and the website added. It was pointed out that a thank you letter had been sent to the new Ranger, Jamie Marlow for work undertaken at All Saints' Church in January.
Under February works to be undertaken, a Councillor asked why permission was needed for the hedge reduction along footpath 13.
[Post meeting note: Footpath 13 runs along the back of Grove Crescent and along the playing field belonging to Hertfordshire County Council and leased to Mr Foster].
- EA645/10 Tree Bulletin
The supplement of tree works that was distributed at the meeting was noted by Members. The supplement included the notices put up in Croxleyhall Woods by TRDC to notify residents of forthcoming works. The Chairman stated that Darren Monk of TRDC had been very impressed with the Parish Council Rangers work in the woods and requested that this be minuted.
