The Senior Ranger acknowledged that the CMS had taken on some of the Council's recommendations in relation to Stone's Orchard.

The Clerk reminded the Chairman that the supporting information provided by CMS in the e-mail that was circulated with the agenda was only the aims and objectives and not a confirmed management plan.

The Senior Ranger recommended that any furniture placed in the Orchard should be in keeping with the natural feel of the space.

There was a brief discussion whether the need for a table in Stone's Orchard was necessary.

A Councillor brought attention to the committee as to whether an historical interpretation board at the entrance to the Orchard would be necessary for the residents of Croxley Green as suggested in the aims and objectives from CMS.

The Senior Ranger brought to the committee's attention that a natural history board, rather than a social history, of the Orchard would be more beneficial to residents. There was also a brief discussion with the problems faced with maintenance of the main path, especially in wintery conditions.

Resolved:

- That a further site meeting with CMS should take place as soon as possible.
