War Memorial Repair

Introduction

To discuss undertaking further repairs to the Croxley Green war memorial.

Discussion

During the recent cleaning and re-painting of the War Memorial it became apparent that the cement bonding has begun to crack and deteriorate due to moisture and frosty weather conditions. There is a fear that this weakened bond may lead to the memorial becoming damaged and broken. It is recommended to replace the concrete with a chemical glue, which is not harmful to the memorial, will secure the stones in place and not be as easily corroded by the weather.



In addition, the Korean War memorial stone is showing signs of degradation and discolouration. This will need to be professionally cleaned and restored. The quoted price for all the outlined works is £1450.

It is recommended that the works are undertaken by military grave restorer, Steve Davis, who operates a Community Interest Company specialising in war memorial restoration and has previously worked on the Croxley Green memorial.

Recommendation

- That the Croxley Green war memorial is re-sealed, and the Korean War memorial stone cleaned, at a total cost of £1450.
