Assets of Community Value Re-nomination

Introduction

This paper seeks approval from members to re-nominate the Croxley Green Library and Red Cross Centre as Assets of Community Value (ACVs).

Discussion

Under the Localism Act 2011, Assets of Community Value status offers communities the opportunity to protect buildings and spaces that are of importance to their social wellbeing. It allows the community a 'right to bid' should the assets be put up for sale, thus ensuring these key sites remain accessible to the public.

Both the **Croxley Green Library** and the **Red Cross Centre** were successfully listed as ACVs in 2019 due to their significant contributions to the community. However, ACV status lasts for five years, meaning the current designation will lapse unless re-nominated.

- Approves the re-nomination of the Croxley Green Library and Red Cross Centre as Assets of Community Value.
