CONSULTATION

Future of the Community Bus Service

Introduction

We invite residents who use the Croxley Green Parish Council Community Bus Service to consider the future of the service. Please comment on the issues facing the Council by completing the survey overleaf. This consultation is open for six weeks, until 22nd August 2025, to ALL residents, but we are specifically asking the bus users.

Context

The Community Bus service was established many years ago providing a service escorted by volunteers to and from Croxley Green to the centre of Watford on Fridays. It runs on three routes around Croxley Green, picking up people along each route, and returning along the same three routes about 2 hours later. A couple of years ago, post COVID, the Parish Council agreed to try an additional service, on the same basis, on Tuesdays.

However, the Parish Council is now running at a loss (exceeding our budget). This means that we must either increase the Council tax or find ways to reduce costs met from Council tax. One of the increases is due to running the bus service two days per week, instead of one day.

Benefits

The main EXTRA benefits the Croxley Community Bus service provides compared with the public bus services (which are free to older residents who have a senior bus pass) are:

- the convenience of being collected from and returned to somewhere near home, often to users' front doors,
- having an escorted journey, with friendly volunteers and the experienced driver providing support and assistance,
- social inclusion, being part of a friendly group, offering passengers the opportunity to visit familiar places, and to be part of the wider community, while looking out for one another.

Number of people using the service

The Parish Council maintains a list of the names and addresses of people who wish to use the service. Currently 119 people have registered to use the service.

Costs per passenger

The service costs £200 per day for the hire of the bus and driver – ignoring the administration work that is needed.

- Dividing the ANNUAL cost of providing the service on two days by the TOTAL number of registered users gives an annual cost per user of £172.
- The number of users varies from week to week. On average, on Tuesdays there were 25 passengers per week at an average cost of £8.10 each. On Fridays, 33 passengers per week at an average cost of £6.16 each (return journey).

Options

There are options:

- 1. To continue the service, as at present, and increase the council tax
- 2. To find additional sources of income to supplement the cost of the service
- 3. To revert to providing the service one day per week.
